Republic Airways Reports a 25% increase in January 2007 Traffic

Indianapolis, Indiana, (February 5, 2007) – Republic Airways Holdings Inc. (NASDAQ/NM: RJET), today reported preliminary passenger traffic results for January 2007. The company generated 529.3 million revenue passenger miles (RPMs), a 25.1% increase over the same month last year, while available seat miles (ASMs) increased to 828.6 million, a 25.8% increase. Block hours were 50,649 in January 2007, a 24.9% increase over January 2006. Load factor was 63.9% versus 64.2% in January 2006. A total of 1,010,288 passengers were carried during the month, a 36.2% increase over the same month last year.

Republic Airways Holdings, based in Indianapolis, Indiana is an airline holding company that operates Chautauqua Airlines, Republic Airlines and Shuttle America. The company offers scheduled passenger service on approximately 1,000 flights daily to 88 cities in 36 states, Canada and Mexico through airline services agreements with five major U.S. airlines. All of its flights are operated under its major airline partner brand, such as AmericanConnection, Delta Connection, United Express, US Airways Express and Continental Express. The airline currently employs approximately 3,700 aviation professionals and operates 179 regional jet aircraft including 76 Embraer 170 aircraft and 8 Bombardier CRJ-200 aircraft.
