Republic Airways Reports a 23% increase in July 2007 Traffic

Indianapolis, Indiana, (August 2, 2007) – Republic Airways Holdings (NASDAQ/NM: RJET), today reported preliminary passenger traffic results for July 2007. The company generated 795.1 million revenue passenger miles (RPMs), a 22.6% increase over the same month last year, while available seat miles (ASMs) increased to 990.6 million, a 19.3% increase. Block hours were 58,191 in July 2007, a 16.8% increase over July 2006. Load factor was 80.3% versus 78.1% in July 2006. A total of 1,499,072 passengers were carried during the month, a 22.0% increase over the same month last year.
