Republic Airways Reports a 37% increase in October 2007 Traffic

Indianapolis, Indiana, (November 2, 2007) – Republic Airways Holdings (NASDAQ/NM: RJET), today reported preliminary passenger traffic results for October 2007. The company generated 818.9 million revenue passenger miles (RPMs), a 36.6% increase over the same month last year, while available seat miles (ASMs) increased 29.7% to 1.1 billion. Block hours were 62,994 in October 2007, a 22.1% increase over October 2006. Load factor was 74.8% versus 71.1% in October 2006. A total of 1,551,739 passengers were carried during the month, a 32.5% increase over the same month last year.
